




Master Chart of Metrics




PUBLICATIONS

The highest value for publications is 180, achieved by the SDS department. The average value across departments is 76.50, with the lowest being 26, recorded by the OMFS department.




<u>CITATIONS</u>

Areas for Improvement


1. Increase the number of publications in Web of Science (ISI) indexed journals.

Areas for Improvement




FUNDED RESEARCH

The highest value for funded research is 15, achieved by the SDS department. The average value across departments is 6.83, with the lowest being 0, recorded by the OMFS department.




NON-FUNDED RESEARCH

The highest value for non-funded research is 165, achieved by the SDS department. The average value across departments is 69.67, with the lowest being 26, recorded by the OMFS department.




INDEXED-ISI SCOPUS


OTHER INDEXING

The highest value for other indexing is 118, achieved by the SDS department. The average value across departments is 44.33, with the lowest being 2, recorded by the DDS department.




Intern Research

The highest value for intern research is 5, achieved by the POS department. The average value across departments is 2.17, with the lowest being 0, recorded by the OMFS department.




Staff Research

The highest value for staff research is 35, achieved by the PCS department. The average value across departments is 23.17, with the lowest being 7, recorded by the OMFS department.




Student research

The highest value for student research is 3, achieved by the POS department. The average value across departments is 0.67, with the lowest being 0, recorded by the DDS department.




Research Collaboration
